



Jingle All The Way 5K COVID-19 Safety Protocol

HEALTH & SAFETY

The Jingle All The Way 5K has been a pinnacle event for The Greg Hill Foundation for the past 8 years. As always, the health and safety of our participants, volunteers, and staff is the most important aspect of this event. Please merrily accept and abide by our protocols below to ensure all of our runners have a holly jolly Jingle All The Way 5K experience!

MASK / FACE COVERING REQUIREMENTS

In accordance with NH Governor Sununu's [Emergency Order 63 Pursuant Executive Order 2020-04 and Extend by Order 2020-05 to 2020-16](#), face coverings will be required for this event at all times, with the exception of when running or walking on the course. If you are not wearing your face mask while running or walking on course, please be mindful of other participants and remain 6 feet apart at all times.

If runners will not be running with their mask on, it is the runner's responsibility to have a proper face covering on hand for after they cross the finish line.

REGISTRATION

Runner registration packets will be mailed to each runner prior to the race. Your registration packet will include your bib and timing chip, race pullover (if applicable) and any merchandise that was purchased with your registration. THERE WILL BE NO ON SITE REGISTRATION.

START LINE PROCEDURES

Please remain in your car until prior to your start time. Face masks will be required while moving to and from the start line. Arrive at the start line no more than 10 minutes before your starting time and no less than 5 minutes to limit number of people at the start line.

The event will utilize corral start format that will limit the number of participants at the start line at one time. Participants will be broken out into four different start times throughout the morning. Groups of 125 participants will take off at the start line based on the time they registered for. The start/finish line will have markers for each runner to stand at to appropriately distance the runners while waiting to begin their race.

Final instructions regarding race day will be emailed out 2 days prior to the event with additional event information and day of logistics.

ON COURSE

Participants are not required but are encouraged to wear their face mask while running or walking on course. While you are not wearing your face mask, please be mindful of other participants on course and remain 6 feet apart from other participants at all times. Runners will be required to have a mask while waiting to cross the start line in the corral and available to put



on as soon as they cross the finish line upon completion of their run. There will be no water stops on course. Participants will be responsible to bring any on course water they would like. Participants will be provided bottled water at the finish line upon completion.

SPECTATORS

All spectators are required to abide by social distancing guidelines and avoid congregating along the course and at the finish line/post-race areas.

BATHROOMS

Port-o-potty's will be available in the start/finish area. Please utilize the hand sanitizer provided inside and outside of the unit.

POST RACE REFRESHMENTS

All adult in-person (21+) participants will have bib tear off tags for 1 post-race drink redeemable at the tent in the Tuscan Kitchen parking lot. ID required. All participants will receive a box with post-race snacks and their finisher medal.

RESULTS

Finisher medals will be handed out upon completion of the race. All results will be shared on The Greg Hill Foundation social media pages following the completion of the race. Participants will receive an email with information on where to find their results.

CANCELLATION POLICY

The Greg Hill Foundation, the City of Salem New Hampshire and Tuscan Village reserve the right to cancel this event due to COVID-19 related issues. If the event is cancelled, refunds will be available to those who were planning on participating in person.
